Come to EID's May 14th, 9AM Board meeting to see EID Management continue their proposal to give a **75% water rate discount to Placerville.**

And come see EID Management's continuing proposal to give **TRIPLE credit for Placerville property taxes** (*i.e., 10.4% of water fund property tax credits vs. just 3.57% of water costs*).

The new Placerville rates EID Management is proposing **would increase Placerville** residential water rates **just \$1.08 monthly vs. EID's \$6.08 monthly increase** (as *headlined in EID's Proposition 218 Notice*) on EID's residential ratepayer using 9% GREATER consumption. How does a six-fold rate increase preference to Placerville support EID's Proposition 218 Notice repeated claims of "fair and equitable" rates?

Will EID's Board stand tall and tell EID Management that special multi-million dollar financial favors to Placerville are not "fair and equitable" to EID's 38,600 residential, commercial and recreational turf ratepayers?

Will Placerville be told it has to pay its "fair and equitable" share of EID's costs?

Will EID's Board adhere to Proposition 218 non-subsidization provisions?

Or will EID's Board race to push the green button to approve Management's proposed multi-million dollar four years of rate subsidies to Placerville at the expense of 38,600 regular EID ratepayers from El Dorado Hills to Pollock Pines?
